For more than ten (10) years, Clouds Hill has worked with local and state workforce training programs. These organizations include Warwick Transition Program, Perspectives, Living Innovations, Avatar Residential, and Kaleidoscope Family Solutions. It has been and continues to be our goal to assist training students with disabilities to become confident in landscaping and the many related tasks, eventually becoming independent enough to seek and gain employment and, ultimately, to live meaningful adult lives.

The training received is hands on. Students learn how to do things that so many consider everyday tasks – how to use a lawnmower, leaf blower, and even rakes. They also gain experience in planting and caring for lawns and flowers.

As does all equipment, the equipment used gets old and is retired. To continue our partnership with this program, we are constantly replacing equipment and purchasing additional supplies. This year we need to replace a lawnmower, hand tools – rakes, brooms, wheel barrows, orange cones, buckets, gloves and goggles.
